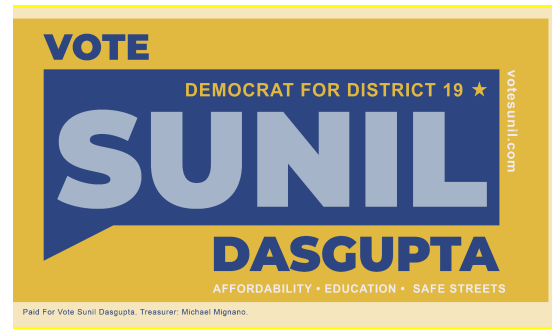


# ENDORSEMENT ALERT

## Maryland State Education Association Endorses Sunil Dasgupta for Maryland House of Delegates District 19
